

Vibra Hospital of Northern California Notice of Charity Care and Discounted Services

Vibra Hospital of Northern California has a financial assistance program for low income, uninsured individuals who may not be able to pay their healthcare bills. This program provides for full or partial discounts based on the following criteria and definitions:

Definition of Charity Care for Self- Pay Patients: A self-pay patient is eligible for charity care (free care) based upon meeting the income eligibility criteria established by the Hospital. Financial eligibility criteria is derived from the most recently published US Department of Health and Human Services Annual Update of the HHS Poverty Guidelines, also referred to as the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). The income eligibility criterion for free care is defined as an income that is less than or equal to 200% of the FPL.

Definition of Discount Payment Plan for Insured Patients: An insured patient is eligible for a discount plan based on meeting the income eligibility criteria and has high medical costs. The income eligibility criterion is defined as an income that is at or below 400% of the FPL. High medical costs are defined as annual out-of-pocket costs incurred by the patient at the hospital that exceed the lesser of 10% of the patient's current family income or 10% of the family income in the prior 12 months.
